THE YUGAVATAR: SRI SATHYA SAI BABA

In the history of mankind whenever dharama faced decadence, God descended to protect the righteous and destroy the wicked. He heard the prayers of devotees and assumed the form suiting to the time, trend and situation. Sri Sathya Sai Baba avatar is the avatar of highest stature and divine powers. He fulfills all the characteristics of being full avatar as mentioned in various scriptures of different religions and naadis written by eminent rishis thousands of years back. From very childhood or even prior to his birth, Baba displayed his powers of omnipresence, omnipotence and omniscience. It is not incredible and a matter of debate. With his extraordinary vision, miraculous powers and leadership Baba led the masses world over to learn to live a life full of bliss, prosperity and service to others.

Born in a tiny and backward village of Puttaparthi on 23 November 1926, he left his home to serve the mankind at the tender age of fourteen. To his devotees, Sathya Sai Baba is incarnation of divinity and possesses miraculous powers of creation, transformation and selfless service. In 1944, a small temple was built for Sathya Sai Baba's devotees at Puttaparthi and in 1950 a sprawling ashram popularly called the 'Prasanthi Nilayam' was built, making it his permanent abode. His divine preaching apart, Sathya Sai Baba pioneered many social service activities beginning with a tiny general hospital at Puttaparthi, now there is a Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Medical Sciences, a 220-bedded super-speciality hospital. Another super-speciality 333-bedded SSIHMS was established at Whitefield on the outskirts of Bangalore, where the Baba's summer abode and campus of Sai University also stands. The Sathya Sai Central Trust manages all the service activities and also runs the Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning at Puttaparthi with three more campuses located in Anantapur, Whitefield and Muddenhalli. Besides, the Trust also runs many schools and dispensaries in different states while it has also completed large water supply projects in Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra. Volunteers from the Sathya Sai Seva Organisation are always found in the forefront carrying out relief and rehabilitation work during natural calamities through all the states of India. Baba founded Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organization in the 1960s with the purpose of enabling its members to undertake service activities as a means to spiritual advancement. According to Baba, "The main purposed of Sri Sathya Sai Organization ... is to help you recognize the divinity inherent in you. So, your duty is to emphasize the One, to experience the One in all you do or speak. Do not give importance to differences of religion, sect, status, or colour. Have the feeling of oneness permeate all your acts. Only those who do so have a place in this Organization; the rest can withdraw."

There are more than 1,200 Sathya Sai Baba Samithies in 130 countries worldwide which constitute a genuine spiritual movement i.e. moving away from body consciousness and selfishness to God consciousness and selflessness and ; moving toward a world where acknowledgement of and love for God results in the harmonious and loving interaction of all members of the holy human family. Samithies' activities include the study of the teachings of Sathya Sai Baba and the sacred literature of all religions, group devotional singing, spiritual meditation, and selfless service to the community, society, the world, and the environment. The membership includes people from all walks of life, and all programs are compatible with all the

major religions. There is never a membership fee in a Sathya Sai Baba Samithi. Donations are never solicited.

He used to say "I am God. And you too are God. The only difference between you and Me is that while I am aware of it, you are completely unaware." In previous aeons, the avatars like Ram and Krishna destroyed the wicked and protected the righteous. But if the avatar of Sri Sathya Sai Baba decides to do so, none of us would survive. Therefore, He decided to transform humanity through his teachings, works and message of love. Baba has one to one connection with His devotees. Experiences of devotees and non-devotees too reveal that He cured even the incurable diseases like cancer and HIV, by just reciting the words, 'cancer cancelled' or operating in dreams. Baba's unconditional love often finds its expression in the form of miraculous healings and resurrections that are experienced by countless devotees, practically every micro-second of the day—even today. While a small fraction of these healings have been documented in Sai literature and elsewhere, there are literally billions and billions of miracles that will forever remain silently enshrined in the hearts of those who experienced them.

He rules the hearts of his devotees through his infinite love. He practiced a unique model of serving others without expecting anything in turn. His only instrument which he used to refer in almost all of his hundreds of discourses is LOVE. His is the unique example of LOVE ALL, SERVE ALL in the whole world. He translated this LOVE in his selfless works. He advised his devotees to follow the principle of love. He said that God will not ask you when and where you did service. He will ask, with what motive did you do it? What was the intention that prompted you? You may weigh the service and boast of its quantity. But God seeks quality - the quality of heart, the purity of mind, the holiness of motive. Spend a few minutes every morning and evening in the silence of your own shrine or home; spend them with the highest of all the powers that you know of. Be in His elevating and Inspiring company; worship Him mentally; offer unto Him all the work you do; you will come out of the silence nobler and more heroic than when you went in.

He propagated that all forms of worship go to the God who is One and is omnipresent. We are fortunate to have born during this period when God walked, touched, talked and guided us to realize the divinity within. Let us take the advantage of using each moment to live a life he has destined for us by working selflessly and offering each activity to him. Continue to workship the god you believe in, He would shower his blessings in that form only.



SWAMI'S MESSAGES TOWARDS HIMACHAL

How sacred is Himachal !

Read what Bhagawan said about the significance of Himachal in His discourses

"..... Sankraanthi enables man to turn his vision towards the sublime. It is the day when the apparent Uttharaayan kaala (northward motion of the sun) begins. The day is considered auspicious for man to embark on his journey towards the goal of a purposeful, sacred and blissful life. The north is described as Himaachala. From ancient times, the Himaalayas were regarded as the abode of the Eeshvara (Divine). Himaachala symbolises a heart that is pure and cool as Hima (ice) and steady as a Achala (mountain). The message of Sankranthi is that people should direct their vision towards Himachal in this symbolic sense. It does not mean looking at the north with the physical eyes. It calls for enquiring into the truth of the Spirit with the Jnaana dhrishti (inward eye of wisdom). Sankraanthi signifies this internal vision."

"Your love should be as big as an ocean The Vedas have declared, "Loka samastha sukhino bhavantu (May the whole world be happy)!" Since ancient times, Bharat has propagated spiritual discipline to other countries, ensuring peace and security for the entire humanity. You should have such broad feelings. Your love should be as vast as an ocean. When Jesus was being crucified, people around were weeping. At that moment, an ethereal voice declared, "All are one, My dear son! Be alike to everyone." The same thing is taught by the culture of Bharat wishing the welfare of entire humanity. Unfortunately, with the passage of time, selfishness and self-interest have become rampant. According to Bharatiya (Indian) culture, Uttarayana is considered to be very sacred. The great warrior Bhishma, lying on a bed of arrows, waited for 56 days for the advent of Uttarayana to give up his mortal coil. During Uttarayana, the sun travels toward the north. What does this signify? In the north, we have Himachala (Himalaya mountains), which are said to be the dwelling place of Eswara. When Eswara is all-pervasive, how can we limit him to Himachala? What is the significance of this statement? The word Himachala is made up of two words: Hima + Achala. Hima means snow, which is white and pure. Achala is that which is firm and unshakeable. What is the place to which this description applies? It is the pure heart, where Eswara is installed. It is said, "Eswara sarva bhoothanam (Eswara is the indweller of all beings)." So, in order to see God, you do not need to go anywhere; just turn your vision inward. We cannot call an unsteady and impure heart as Himachala. Only the heart that is pure, peaceful, sacred, unpolluted, and unwavering can be called Himachala. So, when you turn inward, you are in Himachala."

1. तुम जो भी कर्म प्रेम और सेवा की भावना से करते हो, वह तुम्हें परमात्मा की ओर ले जाता है। जिस कर्म में घृणा छिपी होती है, वह परमात्मा से दूर ले जाता है। कर्म ही पूजा है और कर्तव्य-पालन भक्ति है।
2. मानव हृदय में घृणा, लोभ और द्वेष वह विषैली घास हैं जो प्रेम रूपी पौधे को नष्ट कर देती हैं।
3. अपने जीवन को एक गुलाब बनाओ जो सुगंध की भाषा में चुपचाप बोलता है।
4. दुनिया में रहो, लेकिन दुनिया तुम लिए न हो।
5. मैं भगवान हूँ और तुम भी भगवान ही हो। तुममें और मुझमें फर्क केवल इतना है कि मुझे इस बारे में पता है और तुम्हें इस बारे में जरा भी नहीं पता।”
6. मनुष्य को सभी क्षेत्रों में कुछ नियम बनाने की जरूरत है, ताकि वह अपने दैनिक कार्यक्रम के संचालन में परिपक्वता लाकर जीवन जीने की प्रक्रिया

का वास्तविक निर्देशन कर सके, क्योंकि ये भी आचार संहिता का हिस्सा है, इन्हें भी अनुशासन के रूप में देखना चाहिए।

7. सच्चा भक्त वही है, जो भगवान की खुशी को अपनी खुशी मानता है। वह हमेशा भगवान को खुशी देना चाहता है, उनके लिए किसी असुविधा का कारण बनना नहीं चाहता! यह मानकर चलना चाहिए कि भगवान की खुशी में ही आपकी खुशी है और आपकी खुशी में भगवान की! एकता की इस भावना को आत्मसात कीजिए।
8. शिक्षा हमेशा पथ को प्रकाशवान करती है। अज्ञान का अंधकार और संदेह की सांझ इसके दीप्तमान होने के पहले ही गायब हो जाती हैं। शिक्षा का अर्थ सिर्फ ज्ञान के संग्रह में नहीं है, इसके द्वारा मनुष्य के व्यवहार, चरित्र और महत्वाकांक्षा में परिवर्तन ही परिणाम है।
9. भगवान उनकी मौजूदगी की घोषणा नहीं करता है या दरवाजा नहीं पीटता! वह तो बस इंतजार करता है! जैसे ही तुम थोड़ा-सा दरवाजा खोलते हो, सूरज की रोशनी तुरंत भीतर से अंधेरे को बाहर कर देती है। इसलिए जब भी भगवान से मदद मांगी जाती है, वह आपकी ओर सहायता के लिए हाथ बढ़ाए मौजूद होता है।



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
